



9MM CHIAPPA MODEL M1-9



FOLLOWING THE SUCCESS OF THE .22LR VERSION, CHIAPPA FIREARMS' M1 IS NOW AVAILABLE IN 9MM LUGER (9X19). THE REPLICA IS VERY FAITHFUL TO THE ORIGINAL, REPRODUCING DETAILS SUCH AS BAYONET LUG, BUTTONS AND SIGHTS.

The M1-9 is supplied with two 10-round double stack magazines fully compatible with the Beretta M92 and M98 pistol mags, including high capacity versions. Similarly the M1-9 is compatible with most of the accessories available on the market for M1 carbines. The metal rear sight is adjustable for elevation and windage and can be removed for scope mounting. The barrel and bolt are made of steel while the receiver and magazine housing are made of alloy.

The trigger guard, featuring a safety button identical to the original, is made of polymer while the trigger components are steel.

There are two versions of the M1-9, one with a wooden stock and one with a polymer stock.

Camouflage versions are available in the United States, where the M1 model is sold under the brand name Citadel.
